



Kharkhorin & Erdenezuu Monastery



Trip Summary

This 3-day adventure takes you from Ulaanbaatar Karakorum, the to historic site of Genghis Khan's ancient capital, you'll visit Erdene Zuu Monastery, the Kharkhorin Museum, and the Orkhon Valley, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Continuing driving to Khustai National Park, where you'll spot the rare Przewalski's horses and explore the scenic grasslands. This blends journey history, nature, and adventure for an unforgettable Mongolian experience.

Date: June to September **Price:** Starts from \$560

Itinerary

Day 1: Drive to Kharkhorin


After breakfast, drive to karakorum (6-7 hours), stopping at Moltsog Sand Dunes for lunch. Kharkhorin, once the capital under Ogedei Khan, is set in the Orkhon River Valley, rich with archaeological sites, including ancient burial sites and ruins predating Chinggis Khan. Destroyed by the Ming Dynasty in the 14th century, its remains were used to build the Erdenezuu Monastery. In the evening, enjoy optional hikes or visit a nomadic herder family. Dinner and overnight at a local ger camp. (Ger Camp; L, D)

Day 2: Karakorum/Khustai National Park

After breakfast, visit Erdene Zuu Monastery and Karakorum Museum. Then drive back to Ulaanbaatar, stopping at Khustai National Park for dinner and overnight. Here, you can see the rare Przewalski's horses in their natural habitat. (Ger Camp; B, L, D)

Day 3 Drive back to Ulaanbaatar

In the morning, explore the park with an optional visit to a local herder family and the Ongot monuments–ancient stone structures located just outside the western border of Khustai National Park, composed of several granite statues. These monuments date back to the Turkic period, between the 6th and 8th centuries. After exploring the site, enjoy lunch at the camp before returning to Ulaanbaatar in the afternoon, arriving before dinner. (B, L)



Discover the timeless beauty of the Gobi Desert on this immersive 4-day journey. Travel to the Gobi Gurvansaikhan mountains and visit Bayanzag (Flaming Cliffs), famed for its red sandstone formations and fossil discoveries. Explore Yolyn Am, a dramatic gorge known for its scenic hikes and rare wildlife. End your adventure with a return to Ulaanbaatar, filled with unforgettable memories of Mongolia's natural and cultural wonders.

Date: June to September **Price:** Starts from \$630

Itinerary

Day 1: Ulaanbaatar/ Gobi desert

Early in the morning, your guide and driver will pick you up. Begin driving to the Gobi Desert, enjoying a picnic lunch along the way. The destination today is arriving at a ger camp operated by local herders located by the Gobi Gurvansaikhan mountains. With breaks in between, approx. 7 hours driving; (Guest House; L, D)

Day 2: Flaming Cliffs

Spend the day exploring one of the world's most famous dinosaur sites–Bayanzag, or the Flaming Cliffs. These striking red sandstone formations stretch over 3 km and have yielded hundreds of fossils since the early 20th century. Follow in the footsteps of explorer Roy Chapman Andrews, who unearthed the first dinosaur eggs ever discovered here. Enjoy a sunset view before returning to the ger camp. (Guest House; B, L, D)

Itinerary

Day 3. Yolyn Am

After breakfast, drive a short distance to the mountains of Yolyn Am. Enjoy some gentle hiking through steep-sided gorges and highaltitude meadows. While exploring the valleys, birding these beautiful slopes is a real pleasure, and we'll be on the lookout for exciting species such as Bearded and Himalayan Vulture and Saker Falcon in the canyons here. After a picnic lunch, drive a short distance to Havtsgait Petroglyphs, a remarkable collection of ancient rock drawings dating to 3,000-4,000 years ago, located on top of a small rocky mountain top. In the afternoon, return to your ger camp and enjoy dinner. (Guest House; B, L, D; Approx 160 km driving)

Day 4. Drive back to Ulaanbaatar

After breakfast, drive back to Ulaanbaatar, with a picnic lunch along the way. Drop off at your location. (Approx. 650 km driving, B, L)

2. Credit Card

We also accept payments via credit card. Please note that a 4% bank processing fee will be added to the total amount for credit card transactions. Further instructions will be provided upon request.

Once we receive your Trip Application Form, we will send you information on how to wire your deposit (if applicable), as well as a confirmation letter with details about visa requirements and international airfare reservations. Souvenirs:

Like any other places, Mongolia offers great souvenirs ranging from camel wool sweaters to cashmere scarves and traditional wooden puzzle games. Mongolian vodkas can be an excellent gift. At several stores, you can also find a range of traditional Mongolian musical instruments such as the famed Morin Khuur or "horse headed fiddle." Bargaining is not very customary; most items are sold for the price on their labels. If you plan to shop for souvenirs, we recommend purchasing locally as many items as possible since your purchases will be a direct contribution to the local community.

Travel insurance:

With Mongolia stretching over 1.5 million square kilometers and its population concentrated in the cities, we will be traveling through some remote areas away from good roads and medical facilities. We strongly recommend that you consider getting standard emergency medical evacuation insurance as a means to protect yourself from unexpected accidents that can happen during any trip. Nothing is better than traveling with peace of mind knowing that you have prepared for the trip as much as possible in advance.
