


Explore the wilderness on horseback. hike through untouched trails, and experience the warmth of traditional ger camps-all while immersing yourself in the unspoiled beauty of Mongolia.

Itinerary

After meeting your guide and driver in the hotel lobby, set off for the scenic Terelj National Park. Your adventure begins with a visit to the iconic Turtle Rock, followed by the serene Ariyabal Meditation Temple, where a short hike rewards you with sweeping views of the surrounding landscape. Continue to a traditional ger camp nestled deep within the park. After a hearty lunch, saddle up for a peaceful horseback ride along the picturesque Terelj River.

Before returning to Ulaanbaatar in the late afternoon, you'll visit a local herder family for an authentic glimpse into Mongolia's nomadic lifestyle. (L)



Each spring, they gently comb the fiber, then sell it to factories where it's transformed into luxurious garments. This exclusive tour offers a rare look at the full journey—from pasture to product. Visit a herder family outside Ulaanbaatar, then tour the Gobi Cashmere Factory, the city's first and largest of its kind.

Itinerary

In the morning, meet your guide and head to the Mongolian countryside to visit a nomadic family who raises goats and sheep. Discover their ageold lifestyle and learn how cashmere is traditionally collected from their animals. Enjoy a home-cooked Mongolian lunch with the family before returning to Ulaanbaatar. In the afternoon, tour the Gobi Cashmere Factory to see how raw fiber is transformed into luxurious garments, followed by a visit to the factory outlet for shopping.

Enjoy a peaceful 8 km hike through nature and a packed lunch amidst the scenery. Afterwards, return to your accommodation in Ulaanbaatar.



This leisurely walk is ideal for nature enthusiasts and birdwatchers looking for a tranquil day surrounded by the stunning natural beauty of Mongolia.

2. Credit Card

We also accept payments via credit card. Please note that a 4% bank processing fee will be added to the total amount for credit card transactions. Further instructions will be provided upon request.

Once we receive your Trip Application Form, we will send you information on how to wire your deposit (if applicable), as well as a confirmation letter with details about visa requirements and international airfare reservations. Souvenirs:

Like any other places, Mongolia offers great souvenirs ranging from camel wool sweaters to cashmere scarves and traditional wooden puzzle games. Mongolian vodkas can be an excellent gift. At several stores, you can also find a range of traditional Mongolian musical instruments such as the famed Morin Khuur or "horse headed fiddle." Bargaining is not very customary; most items are sold for the price on their labels. If you plan to shop for souvenirs, we recommend purchasing locally as many items as possible since your purchases will be a direct contribution to the local community.

Travel insurance:

With Mongolia stretching over 1.5 million square kilometers and its population concentrated in the cities, we will be traveling through some remote areas away from good roads and medical facilities. We strongly recommend that you consider getting standard emergency medical evacuation insurance as a means to protect yourself from unexpected accidents that can happen during any trip. Nothing is better than traveling with peace of mind knowing that you have prepared for the trip as much as possible in advance.

Traveling with Mongolia Quest:

Because it is still a developing country, traveling in Mongolia requires a sense of humor and patience.
