



TRIP SUMMARY



Of the estimated 4,500-6000 left snow leopards left in the world today, scientists have recorded the largest numbers in China and Mongolia, of which the latter has the easiest access both politically and logistically.

This expedition takes you deep into the Altai mountain range, characterized by steep cliffs, rocky outcrops, and extreme altitudes, creating ideal conditions for snow leopards to hunt, move, and remain unseen.

Joining the journey is a local biologist who will serve as the trip leader, accompanied by local herder-rangers with extensive knowledge of the terrain. With deep field experience in snow leopard ecology and tracking, the biologist will guide daily activities based on fresh signs, camera trap data, and environmental conditions.

During the trip, you will encounter Argali sheep, and Siberian ibex. This tour is a rare opportunity to witness one of the world's most elusive cats while exploring one of Mongolia's most awe-inspiring ecosystems.



TRIP LEADER



Khuderchuluun Gantumur MSc/BSc, National University of Mongolia

Khuderchuluun is a young and promising Mongolian biologist, actively contributes to research and field studies while advocating for responsible wildlife-watching tourism.

Since 2017, he has gained extensive hands-on experience in biodiversity research and wildlife monitoring across Mongolia, working with national parks and leading conservation organizations such as World Wildlife Fund and The Nature Conservancy.

His fieldwork spans a wide range of species from small mammals to Argali sheep and the endangered Saiga antelope.

As your trip leader, Khuderchuluun will offer expertguidance, insightful instruction, and scientific context to deepen your understanding of Mongolia's remarkable wildlife and ecosystems.



ITINERARY

DAY 1. ARRIVAL IN ULAANBAATAR

Upon arrival, meet your guide and transfer to your hotel. After settling and resting in your hotel room, we will enjoy a welcome dinner at a fine local restaurant.

Overnight at hotel. (Hotel Kempinski or similar; D)

DAY 2. WESTERN MONGOLIA

Today, we will fly to the western most part of Mongolia. We will meet our local crew and after a quick

stop at a local market, begin driving to the Altai mountains where our camp site is located. Enjoy dinner and overnight in tents or gers.

Overnight in field camp. (B, L, D, Approx. 7 hours driving)





DAY 3-9. ALTAI MOUNTAINS

In the morning, we will hear a brief introduction on the region's conservation projects for snow leopard and other rare species. We will set out each day to one of the frequently sited valleys in search of the elusive cat. Packed lunch will be provided and we will enjoy dinner at the base camp by a warm fire site.



DAY 10. HOVD CITY

In the morning, transfer back to the local town, Hovd, for our return flight back to Ulaanbaatar the next morning. Overnight at local hotel. (B;L;D. Approx. 7 hours driving)

DAY 11. ULAANBAATAR SIGHTSEEING



After our return flight back to Ulaanbaatar, transfer to your hotel located in the downtown. The restof the afternoon is free for resting at your hotel or last-minute sh opping. Lunch is independent. We will enjoy farewell dinner at a fine local restaurant.

DAY 12. DEPARTURE

After breakfast transfer to the airport for your return flight home. (B)

Ger camp = The traditional portable, circular, wooden dwelling used by the nomadic peoples. Field camp = A bit more sophisticated camping/glamping, more permanent in nature. Tent camp = Expedition style, often moving regularly and smaller in size and scale.

Once we receive your trip application form, we will send you information about how to wire your deposit to us, and a confirmation letter with information related with visa and international airfare reservations. You will also receive our pre-departure Travel Guide, which will include information on weather, suggested reading list, a list of items to pack, etc.

About 4 weeks prior to your arrival date, we will send you Final Departure Information which will include your final itinerary along with any other necessary updated information regarding the logistics of your trip.



PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION POLICY

As mentioned above, a deposit of \$400 per person is required to reserve space for the trip that you have chosen. Full payment is due 90 days prior to the start of the trip. In the case of a cancellation, please contact us in written form.

Notification of cancellation must be received in writing by Mongolia Quest. At the time, we receive your written cancellation, the following penalties will apply:

- Up to 90 days prior to departure: \$250 per person handling fee;
- 89-60 days prior to departure: 20% of the trip cost per person;
- 60-45 days prior to departure: 50% of the trip cost per person;
- 44-30 days prior to departure: 75% of the trip cost, per person;
- 29 days prior to departure, or after the trip starts: no-refund.

Some airfares may be nonrefundable. Once an expedition has departed, there will be no refunds from MQ for any unused portions of the trip. The above policy also applies to all extensions and independent travel arrangements made in conjunction with this program.

Tier pricing

Our prices are based on tier pricing. At the time of booking, we will bill you for the amount based on the confirmed number of trip participants. In case the number of travelers increases at the last moment, we will reimburse the balance of your payment in accordance with the corresponding tier pricing, after you return home.
